

## For Academic Year 2020-2021 Courses ~ Incoming Students Only ~

Check with your counselor for specific details about Heartland courses offered at your school and admission process deadlines.

### Heartland Application

You must submit the Heartland student application to earn both high school **AND** college credit through this program. There is **no** application fee. Students **do not** have to reapply for the program every year.

#### To start the application process:

- Visit [heartland.edu/application](http://heartland.edu/application)
- Scroll down to choose **I'm Ready to Apply Online**.
- Select the following responses as they appear:
  - ▶ Take one or more classes.
  - ▶ I would like to earn HCC credit while I am still in high school.
  - ▶ By choosing from HCC courses offered through my high school/career center.
  - ▶ Select the start term for **Fall 2020**

- You will need to enter your correct birth date, social security number, high school graduation year and an email address other than your high school email address.

- Heartland will send your acceptance letter to the email address you entered on your application 3 to 5 days after successful application submission. [Be sure to check your email spam/junk folder.]

### Placement Testing

You only need to complete placement testing at Heartland if:

1. you do not have other eligible test scores, such as ACT/PSAT/SAT scores.
2. required for a Heartland course you intend to take through your high school.

Your counselor will provide information about requirements for Heartland courses chosen by your high school. Placement testing is **not** required for Heartland courses taken through BACC, LACC or LTEC.

#### To schedule your placement testing appointment:

- Log in to [my.heartland.edu](http://my.heartland.edu) using the information from your acceptance letter.
- Choose **Appointments** from the options in the top menu bar.
- Then choose the **Placement Testing** option.
- Select your desired testing location: Normal OR Lincoln OR Pontiac
- Follow the next prompts to finish making your appointment.

- You must schedule your appointment online 48 hours in advance and/or talk to your counselor about submitting other eligible test scores.

**\*You can request enrollment through your high school counselor if you meet all requirements.\***
