## Section 1-Financial Aid History

### Accessing your Financial Aid History

The National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) is a federal database of every student who has received federal financial aid. By logging into NSLDS, you can view your aid history and other information. Your access to NSLDS is equally important so you can view your financial aid usage, including:

- Your loan balances.
- The interest rates for each of your loans.
- The amount of Pell Grant you have received.
- Your student loan servicer's contact information.
- The current status of your student loans.

### Details You Should Know

There is a lot of information about your federal student loans within NSLDS, but prior to graduation, there will be four pieces of information that will be critical to know as you prepare to manage your debt:

- Loan Type (name)
- Loan Servicer
- Disbursement Dates
- Loan Balances

### Knowing this information will help you:

- Determine which repayment plans you qualify for.
- Find your total loan balance and learn when your first payment is due.
- Know where to send your payment and who to call for assistance.

## What Won't You See in NSLDS?

Details on Private or Institution Loans. NSLDS is for federal loans only. To find the details of other loans you'll want to review your credit report, or reach out to the lender of the loan, or your school's financial aid office.

Real-Time Account Balances are not available. The Outstanding Principal Balance (OPB) of each loan will be listed, but this is not real-time data. To determine the current balance, contact the loan servicer.

## Getting Started

1. Go to NSLDS.ed.gov
2. Select 'Financial Aid Review'
3. Review and Accept the 'Privacy Statement'
4. Enter your FSA ID username and password
5. **Print and submit the page(s) of your loan history. If you do not have any history, print the page that indicates this. Attach to this worksheet.**
